School of Finance, IICA successfully conducted 5-day training programme for 15 Indian Post & Telecommunication Accounts and Finance Service (IP&TAFS, Group ‘A’) Probationers on “Corporate Affairs”, from July 24-28, 2017 at IICA Campus, Manesar. The programme was inaugurated by **Shri Ajay Kumar** (*Deputy Director General, National Institute of Communication Finance*).

The training was designed to provide significant expertise on contemporary issues related to emerging discipline of “Corporate Affairs” like Indian Companies Act 2013, Governing Modern Corporations, Role of ICT and E-Governance, Sustainable Development Goals, CSR Provisions under Companies Act, 2013, Management of CSR Projects, Financial Management of CSR, Governance of Socially Responsible Initiatives, Insolvency and Bankruptcy Provisions, Understanding of Financial Statements, Whole Brain Thinking for Effective Leadership, Mobile Network Transformations, Overview of Competition Law, Jurisprudence related to Telecom and ICT Sector, Startups & SMEs in India, practical implications related to Goods and Services Tax (GST) and Indian Accounting Standards (IndAS).
