

One-Day Training Programme on Companies Act, 2013: A Primer

The School of Corporate Law, IICA in collaboration with the Indian Society of International Law (ISIL) organised a *One-Day Training Programme on Companies Act, 2013* on March 27, 2015 at New Delhi.

The programme commenced with the welcome address by **Shri. Narinder Singh**, Secretary General, ISIL.
